Cricket Unlimited Wireless Service Successfully Launched in Chicago
Doyon Is Controlling Investor in the Chicago Cricket Branded Service Provider

Fairbanks – March 12, 2009 – Cricket unlimited wireless has entered the greater Chicago market. The service is being offered by Denali Spectrum License Operations, LLC, a firm that is owned by Denali Spectrum, which is owned by Denali Spectrum Manager, its managing member, and Cricket Communications, Inc. Denali Spectrum Manager is controlled by Alaska regional Native corporation Doyon, Limited. Cricket Communications, Inc. is a leading provider of unlimited wireless service and a wholly owned subsidiary of Leap Wireless, International, Inc. (NASDAQ: LEAP).

The Cricket wireless service was first offered in the Chicago area on February 17th in key initial retail distribution points and will continue to add new distribution points through March 17th. Chicago is the largest market in which Cricket's unlimited 3G wireless voice and broadband services are offered to date.

In addition to covering the greater Chicago area, there is now contiguous Cricket coverage stretching from more than 60 miles south of Chicago to as far north as central Wisconsin. The Cricket service area covers approximately 16,255 square miles and approximately 10.4 million people.

Norman L. Phillips, Jr., President and CEO of Doyon, Limited says that Doyon is "pleased to be offering Cricket service in Chicago. Cricket is a leader in providing affordable, unlimited wireless voice and broadband Internet services across the United States."

The introduction of Cricket service in Chicago creates more than 2,150 jobs in the area, including approximately 1,800 new positions created through the Cricket dealer network.
